Students in grades K-3 are invited to make STEAM night projects on any science, engineering or math topic. Individual and group projects (up to 4 kids) are welcome. Students may do experiments and present their results. Alternatively, students may read up on a topic, such as dinosaurs or the solar system, and present what they have learned. Students and parents will view the projects and ask questions about them. As a special feature, we have invited volunteer scientists and engineers in the community to interview the students about their projects - no judging, just fun! There are lots of resources available online to give the kids ideas about projects. Students may also find science project in books in our school library or at the public library (call numbers around J 507).

Rules

The project must fit on a surface the size of a student desk. All students should be careful NOT to select a topic that involves any of the following:

- fires or flames or explosive chemical reactions
- animals--alive or dead
- harmful microorganisms
- blood or body fluids
- harmful chemicals
